Participants will learn how to properly and safely handle and assemble the equipment and how to correctly deliver supplemental oxygen through the appropriate delivery device. Course can also be combined with Basic Life Support and Airway Management.

Audience

In-facility care providers, including nursing staff, care aides, medical and dental professionals. Pre-hospital care providers, which may include professionals in a fire service, rescue team, sports-medicine, lifeguards and ski patrol.

Duration

- Stand-alone course or Combined with BLS, course times generally 2:30 to 5pm (2-3 hours)

- Pulse oximetry ranges, values and treatments
- Supplemental oxygen
- Oxygen delivery devices including nasal cannula, non-rebreather masks, Bag Valve Masks (BVM's) with oxygen reservoir, resuscitation masks and standard masks
- Administering supplemental oxygen from oxygen cylinders with the use of regulators
- Duration of flow calculations
